Author Contract

The Penn Bioethics Journal (henceforth referred to as “the Journal”) is intended as a forum for the communication and exchange of ideas between undergraduates interested in bioethics or related fields. The Journal provides undergraduate students pursuing an area of inquiry within bioethics or related fields the opportunity to gain experience in the creation and submission of academic manuscripts for publication. The Journal reserves the right to publish submitted papers in both print and electronic form and on EBSCO.

All persons designated as authors need not qualify for authorship as undergraduates. As long as the primary author qualifies, secondary authors can include advisors and professional investigators. The primary author should have contributed significantly to the concept and design of the work and writing the manuscript to take public responsibility for it. The editor may request justification of assignment of authorship. Names of those who contributed general support or technical help may be listed in an acknowledgment.

Authors of papers accepted for publication retain the right to present any and all of the original ideas in the paper in other fora, provided they are accompanied with the appropriate citation for the Journal. The author may not publish the same or a sufficiently similar manuscript in other publications. If the author draws on ideas from their paper published in the Journal for their future work, the appropriate citation must be used.

The Journal will not publish manuscripts without receiving this form from each author of the manuscript and the faculty sponsorship form completed by the supervisor or mentor of the author(s).

By signing this agreement, the author agrees to the above terms. They further assert that the submitted manuscript is without breach of academic integrity or honesty, and that all original content in their manuscript is accurate and authentic.
